## CHAPTER IIt-Group 2: Impraped Touring Cars

## 262-General Specification

All provisions of Chapter IL concerning series Touring cars apply likewise to Group 2 cars with the exception of third paragraph of Art. 257 conceming cars whose building has been abandoned since mors than four years.

## 263-Changes and additions authorised

In addition to the 18 latiudes granted for cars of Group I, the following changes and extra equipment are authorised.
(19) Wheels; may be of a different type than the one or those prorided by the manulacturer provided the hub nemains unchanged as well as the dimensions of (lie rim and of the track provided and stated by the manufacturer.
(20) Reboring: authorised in the same conditions as for cars of the first group (cf Att. 261-8), bul with a maximum tolerance of 1.2 man. (instead of 0.6).
(21) Stabiliser: the fiuing of a commencial suspension stabiliser or equivalent device is authorised, on condition it does not constitute an additional stay mod.
(22) Oil filler: an oil filter may be added when the moder provided by the manufacturer has none.
(23) Springs of any kind (valwes, clutch, suspension, etc.): They may be replaced by other ones of unresticeed origin, but withont modification of the number provided by the manufachurer and on condition they can be fifed without any alleration of the original supports.
(24) Finishing off; all perfecting operations by finishing or machining the original parts but not their replacement except with regard to springs as specified here-above. In other words, provided it is always possible to ascartain nnquestionably the origin of the series production part, it may be rectified, balanced, lightened, reduced or modified with regard to the shape through tooling, to the exclusion of any addition of material or any mechanical extension or of any process involving a change of the characteristics of the molecular structure or of the surface of the metal.

The increase of the compression ratio through machining the cylindar head or block, or using a thinner gasket or doing without one, is authonised.
(25) Braking: the braking power may be increased subject to the system of operation provided by the manubaclurer (drum brakes or disc brakes) being maintaíned as well as the original supporls (see Art. 261, par. 15).

NB.-Any alberation or addilion nol specifically provided here-aboye will make the vabicle unfil for classification in Group 2 and will resulit in its being affected to that of the two ather groups of the present regulations which applies.

Any alteration or addition not listed above and which has not been subject to a previous written statement of the entrant will encail a pettalty which may go as far as exclusion from the comm petifion without prejudice to higher penalties in case of wilful mísrepresentation.
